



## CONSTITUTION

### 1. NAME:

The name of the Society is FEDERATION OF CANADIAN ARTISTS (hereinafter called the "Federation").

### 2. PURPOSES:

- a) To educate and increase the public's understanding and appreciation of the visual arts by providing facilities for the public exhibition of artistic works and by providing seminars on topics related to such exhibitions.
- b) To provide and make available instructional seminars and written material on topics related to the visual arts
- c) To produce art exhibitions for the purposes of educating and advancing the public's understanding and appreciation of the visual arts and to educate artists through participation in such exhibitions and related workshops.
- d) To educate the public in visual arts through workshops and seminars.

### 3. LOCATION:

The head office of the Federation shall be located in Vancouver, British Columbia.

### 4. DISSOLUTION:

Upon winding up or dissolution of the Society, the assets which remain after payment of all costs, charges, and expenses which are properly incurred in the winding up shall be distributed to such charitable organization or organizations registered under the provisions of the Income Tax Act (Canada) as may be determined by the members of the Society at the time of winding up or dissolution. This provision shall be unalterable.
